Ella Fitzgerald was an American jazz singer and songwriter who was widely considered one of the greatest jazz vocalists of all time. She was born on April 1917 ,25, in Newport News, Virginia, and died on June 1996 J.5, in Beverly Hills, California. Fitzgerald's singing was characterized by her clear, powerful voice, her ability to convey emotion and her wide range of vocal styles. She was known for her scat singing, a technique where a singer improvises using nonsense syllables, which she excelled at. She also was known for her impeccable phrasing, intonation and her ability to swing.


