

MARCUS GARVEY



Marcus Garvey was a Jamaican political leader, publisher, journalist, and orator who was a staunch advocate of the Black nationalism movement and the Back-to-Africa movement. He

Garvey was a self-educated man who became deeply involved in the political and social issues of his time.
