



THE SHOT HEARD 'ROUND THE WORLD

On April 19, 1775, in the town of Lexington, Massachusetts, the first shots of the American Revolution were fired. Nobody knows who fired first, but this moment became famous as "the shot heard 'round the world." It marked the beginning of a big fight for freedom.
