

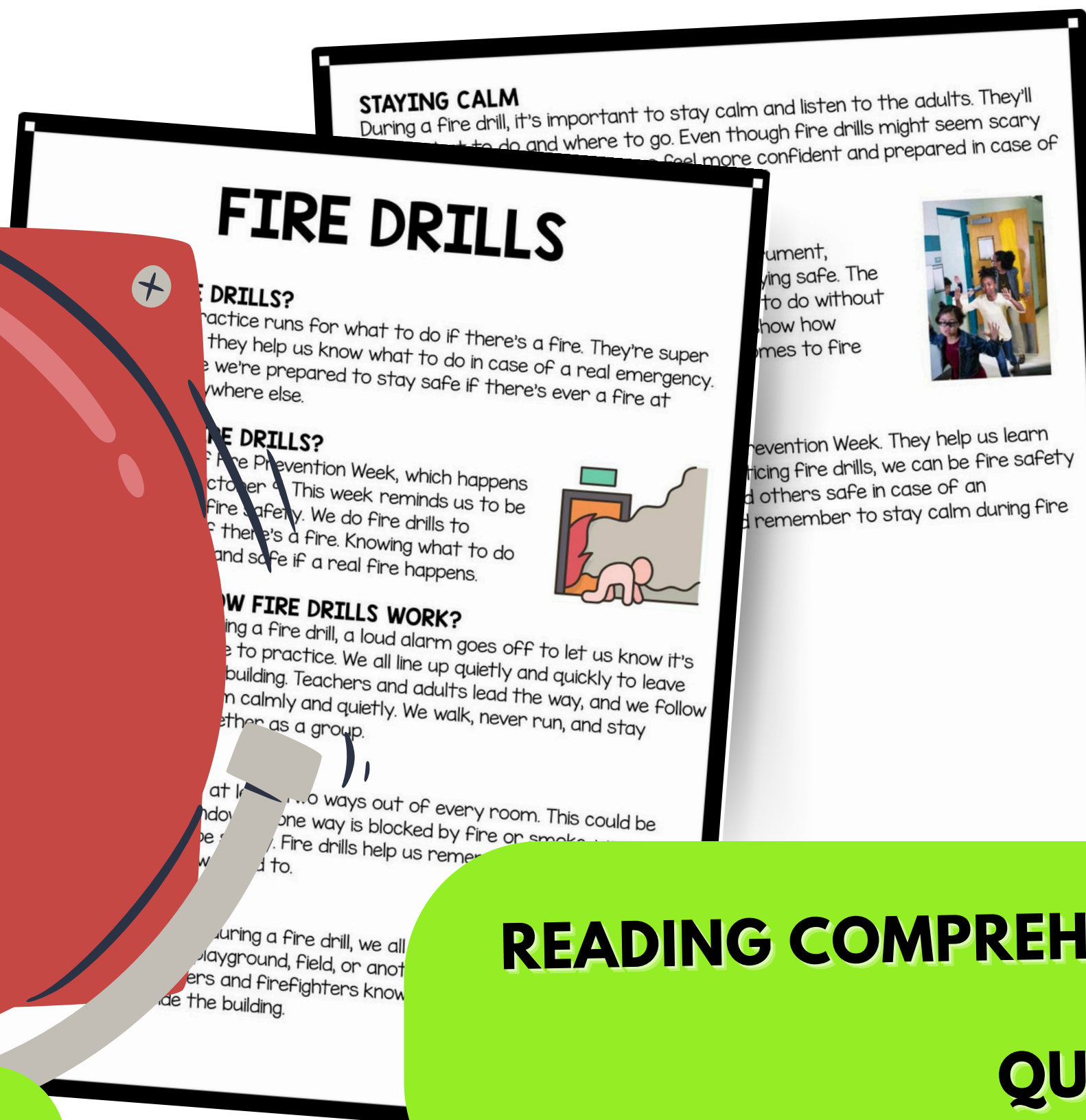

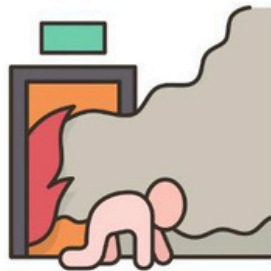
FIRE DRILLS
