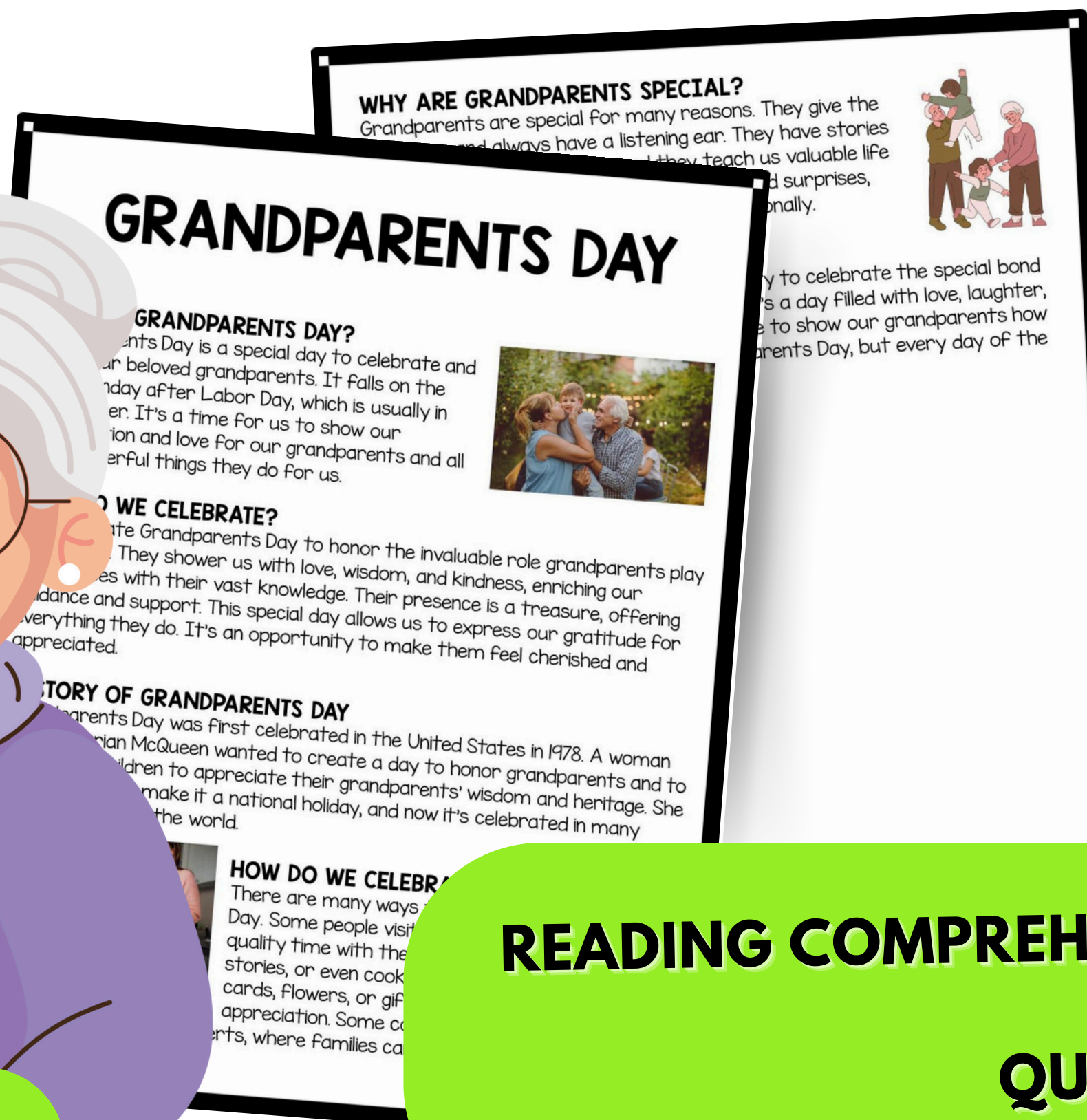

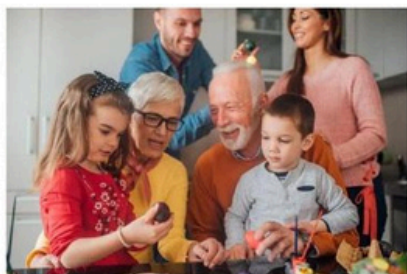


WHY DO WE CELEBRATE?
