Animals move from one place to another at certain times of the year. This is called migration. Some animals migrate to find food, some to have babies, and some to escape the cold. For example, birds fly south in the winter where it's warmer. They return north in the spring when it's warmer there. Fish swim long distances to lay their eggs in special places. Even some insects, like butterflies, migrate! Migration helps animals survive.

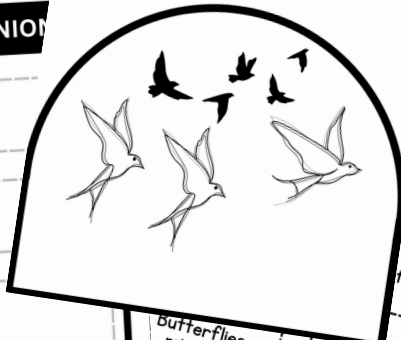
