Ramadan is a special time for Muslims around the world. It is the ninth month of the Islamic lunar calendar. During Ramadan, Muslims fast from dawn until sunset. This means they don't eat or drink anything during daylight hours. Fasting helps Muslims learn self-control, feel empathy for those who are hungry, and grow closer to Allah. At the end of each day, Muslims break their fast with a meal called iftar. Families gather together to enjoy iftar and pray. Ramadan is also a time for giving to those in need, called charity or zakat. Muslims believe that during Ramadan, the Quran, the holy book of Islam, was revealed to the Prophet Muhammad. Ramadan is a time of reflection, prayer, and community for Muslims all over the world.
