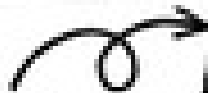
Tribe of Origin/Association: Allan Houser was a Chiricahua Apache artist.

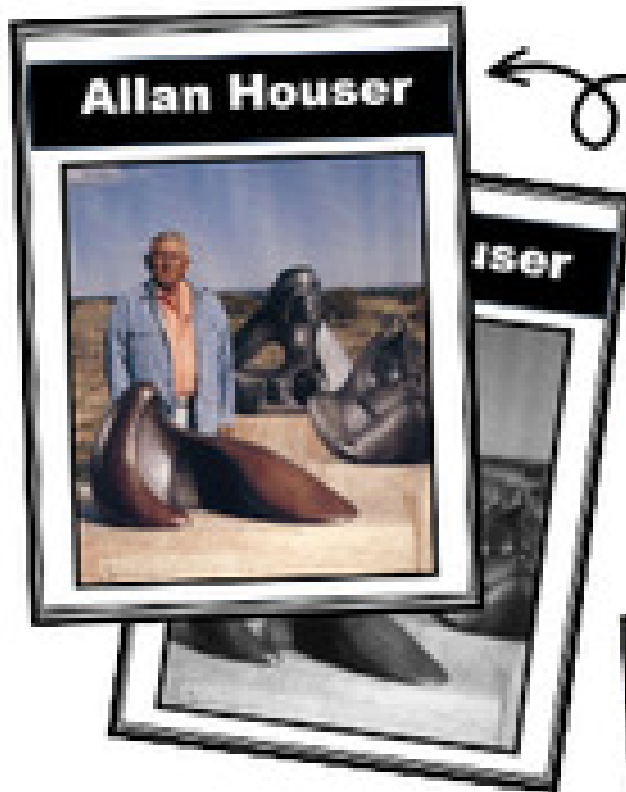

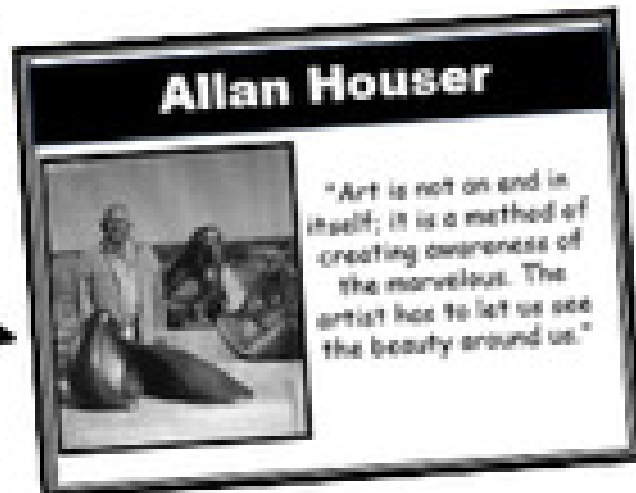
