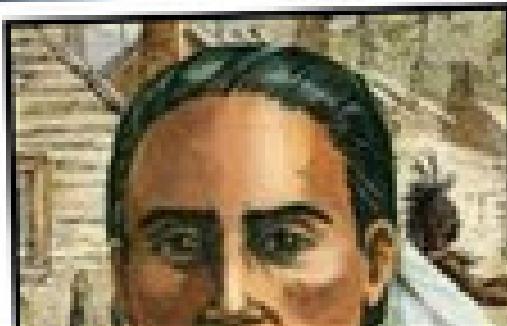

role in helping the Pilgrims survive in the New World by
teaching them essential survival skills and acting as an
interpreter of California in the world of motorsports.

ASSOCIATED
TRIBE

Squanto, also known as Tisquantum, was a
Native American man who played a crucial role in facilitating
peaceful relations between the Wampanoag people
and the English Pilgrims who arrived on the
Mayflower in the early 17th century. Born around
1585, Squanto was instrumental in helping the
Pilgrims learn to survive in the new land by teach-
ing them agricultural techniques and serving as
a translator. His contributions were vital to the
successful establishment of Plymouth Colony and
the friendly interactions between the indigenous
Wampanoag and the English settlers.

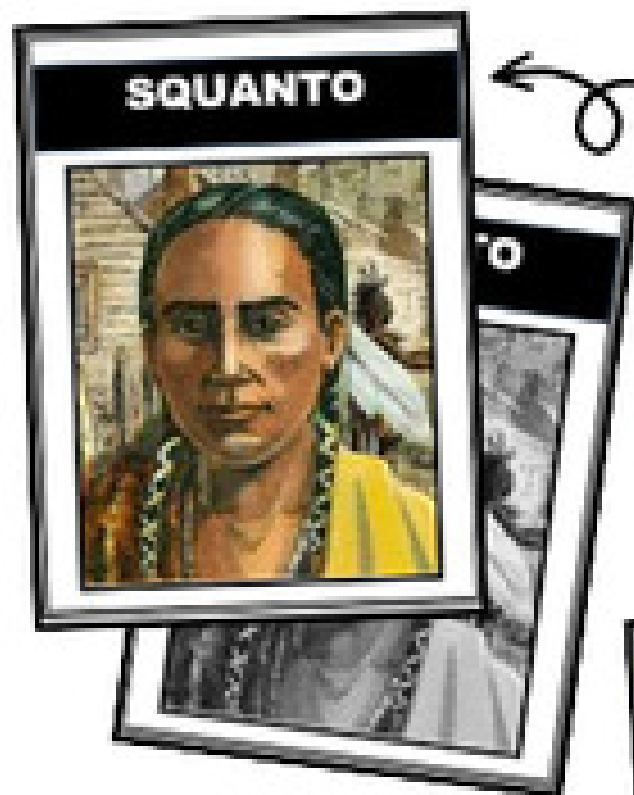
