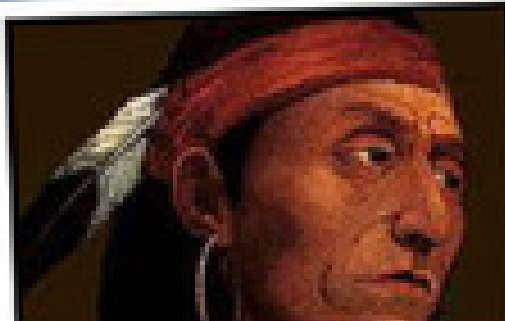

Tribe of Origin/Association: Ottawa tribe; Modern-day residence: Michigan and Oklahoma. Pontiac was a respected leader of the Ottawa tribe, known for his role in organizing a major Native American rebellion against the British during the 18th century, known as Pontiac's War.

Pontiac was a prominent 18th-century Ottawa war chief known for his leadership during Pontiac's War, a conflict against British military forces in the Great Lakes region. Born around 1720, Pontiac was instrumental in organizing a coalition of various Native American tribes to resist British expansion into Native American territories after the French and Indian War. While the conflict ultimately ended with a treaty, Pontiac's efforts were significant in showing Native American resistance against European powers during the early colonial period in North America.

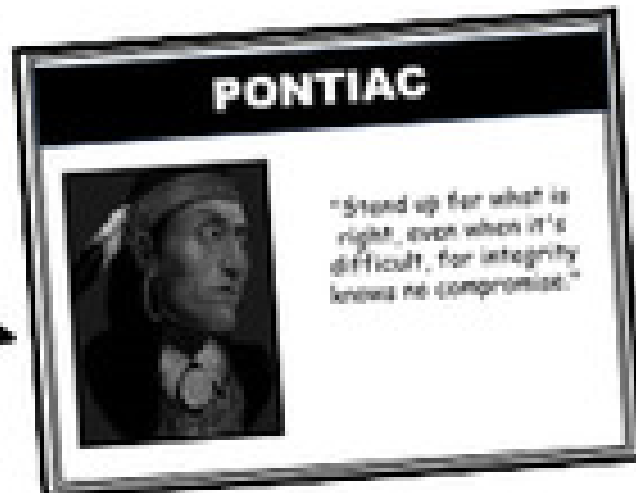
